Yip Hon Weng is a first-term elected Member of Parliament representing Yio Chu Kang Single Member Constituency. Hon Weng's career began in the Education Service before transitioning to the Singapore Government's Administrative Service. As a senior Administrative Service Officer, he has held significant leadership and policy roles across key ministries, including Manpower, Defence, National Development, and Health, as well as in the Prime Minister's Office. Known for being hands-on, Hon Weng consistently ensures that policies are effectively implemented on the ground by personally liaising with multiple agencies. Through this experience, he developed extensive skills in organizing nationwide outreach programs and gained a deep appreciation for the power of community networks in helping fellow Singaporeans. Hon Weng also served as the founding director of the Ageing Planning Office in the Health Ministry, where he spearheaded national strategies to address the challenges faced by the elderly. His work in this area made him a strong advocate for seniors' issues, a cause he continues to champion both in Parliament and through grassroots efforts.

Currently, Hon Weng is a Director at Temasek, a global investment firm. One of his roles includes leveraging his expertise in finance and cutting-edge technology to seek out early-stage deep technology investments with disruptive potential. This role allowed him to remain at the forefront of technological advancements while contributing to Singapore's broader economic strategy. He currently spearheads workforce-related strategies and policies for Temasek and its ecosystem and portfolio companies.

Throughout his career, Hon Weng has remained driven by a desire to serve the community. Although he never envisioned himself in politics, his exposure to the needs of diverse segments of society inspired him to take on the role of an MP. He counts it a privilege to serve his constituents, striving to make a meaningful difference in their daily lives.
