5. The Chief Minister to move—

that pursuant to section 54 of the Singapore Colony Order in Council, 1955, the First Standing Orders of the Assembly made by the Governor on the 14th day of April, 1955, as amended by the Assembly on 10th February, 1956, be revoked with effect from 1st January, 1957;

that pursuant to section 54 of the Singapore Colony Order in Council, 1955, the Standing Orders as contained in Appendix II of the aforesaid Second and Final Report of the Standing Orders Committee be made as the Standing Orders of this Assembly with effect from 1st January, 1957.

6. The Chief Minister to move—

That this Assembly resolves that the Standing Orders Committee, appointed under paragraph (3) of Standing Order 61, do consider and report on such further amendments to the Standing Orders of this Assembly as in the opinion of the Committee appear to be necessary or desirable.

7. The Chief Minister to move—

That a Select Committee comprising Mr. Speaker as Chairman and thirteen members to be nominated by the Committee of Selection be appointed to examine, report upon and make recommendations in respect of matters necessary to enable effect to be given to the resolution of the Assembly on 9th February, 1956, that for the purposes of oral debate the languages of the Assembly should be English, Malay, Mandarin and Tamil; and that the Report from the Select Committee on Languages in Legislative Assembly Debates in the previous Session, as contained in Sessional Paper No. L.A. 7 of 1956, be referred to this Select Committee.

8. The Minister for Labour and Welfare to move—

That the Report from the Select Committee on the Singapore Youth Sports Centre Incorporation Bill, as contained in Sessional Paper No. L.A. 13 of 1956, be adopted.
