QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Mr. Chia Thye Poh: To ask the Deputy Prime Minister whether he is aware that there is no bus route along Jalan Bahar off Jurong Road 13½ milestone and whether a bus service can be authorised to serve that area.
- *2. Mrs. C. V. Devan Nair: To ask the Minister for Finance (a) whether he is aware of the undertaking given by the Government, contained in a collective agreement with the Public Daily Rated Employees' Unions Federation in 1961, that quarters would be built for public daily-rated employees every year; (b) how many such quarters have been built by the Government over the last two years; and (c) what the Government proposes to do in order to implement the undertaking.
- *3. Mr. Chia Thye Poh: To ask the Minister for Education whether the Government has any plans to establish a school in Bulim Village at 12 milestone Jurong Road, and what language will be the medium of instruction in this school.
- *4. Mr. Chia Thye Poh: To ask the Minister for National Development whether he is aware that the following tracks in the Jurong area are in a state of disrepair and whether he will take steps to have them repaired: (i) Tuas Road; (ii) Track 37 (Lokyang Road); (iii) Track 18.
