That this Assembly pursuant to the provisions of subsection (1) of section 4 of the Entertainments Duty Ordinance (Chapter 161) resolves that there shall be imposed upon every payment set out in the First Column of the Schedule hereto for admission to any entertainment, including admission to an amusement park, entertainments duty at the rate set out opposite thereto in the Second Column of the said Schedule.
