†1. Clerks Employment Bill:

The Minister for Labour and Welfare will move the following amendments to the Bill on recommittal to a Committee of the whole Assembly:-

- (i) Clause 27, page 21, line 27: after "of", to insert "subsection (1) of".
 (ii) Clause 28, page 22, line 3: after "of", to insert "subsection (1) of".
- (iii) Clause 29, page 22, line 14: after "of", to insert "subsection (1) of".

(iv) Clause 46:

- (a) Page 27, line 27: after "46.", to insert a dash and "(1)".
- (b) Page 27, after line 44: to insert the following new sub-clause (2):-

"(2) No answer which a person shall be legally bound to give under the provisions of paragraph (a) of the preceding subsection shall be proved against him in any criminal proceeding, except on a prosecution for giving false evidence by such answer.".

**3. Shop Assistants Employment Bill:

Subject to the motion being agreed to, the Minister for Labour and Weifare will move the following amendments to the Bill on recommittal to a Committee of the whole Assembly:—

- (i) Clause 2, page 3, lines 16 and 18: after "shop", in each case to insert "or theatre".
- (ii) Clause 28, page 10, line 28: after "of", to insert "subsection (1) of".
- (iii) Clause 29, page 11, line 5: after "of", to insert "subsection (1) of".
- (iv) Clause 30, page 11, line 16: after "paragraph (e) of", to insert "subsection (1) of".
- (v) Clause 34, page 12, lines 2 to 4: to leave out "which shall be the day on which the shop is required to remain closed in pursuance of the provisions of section 35 of this Ordinance".
- (vi) Clause 50:
 - (a) Page 17, line 14: after "50.", to insert a dash and "(1)".
 - (b) Page 17, after line 32: to insert the following new sub-clause (2):---

"(2) No answer which a person shall be legally bound to give under the provisions of paragraph (a) of the preceding subsection shall be proved against him in any criminal proceeding, except on a prosecution for giving false evidence by such answer."
