QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Mr. Ho See Beng: To ask the Minister for Education whether teachers with the Higher School Certificate, whether in Government or Government-aided schools and in any of the four language streams, are given one increment more than those with the School Certificate; whether some teachers with the Higher School Certificate have not been given the additional increment, and if he will put the matter right.
- *2. Mr. Ho See Beng: To ask the Minister for Finance if he knows how many Singapore Sweep tickets have been sold up to a latest convenient date; and what percentage of the proceeds is collected by Government and what percentage is retained by the Singapore Turf Club.
- *3. Mr. Ho See Beng: To ask the Minister for Culture and Social Affairs if he will consider increasing the amount of public assistance in respect of old-aged persons and widows.
