- *1. **Mr Arthur Fong:** To ask the Minister for National Development in view of the limited residential and commercial land in Singapore, will he require HDB and URA, when inviting tenders from developers to buy land for development in built up residential estates particularly the HDB heartland, to consider the views of residents who will be affected by the development.
- *2. **Mr Arthur Fong:** To ask the Minister for Health if the Government will consider allowing Medisave to pay for the hospitalisation and delivery cost for the fourth child, as there is a growing number of Singaporeans affected by the current ruling, and falling fertility rate, which currently at 1.48, is among the lowest in the world.
