QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Education whether he is aware that many teachers, who do extra-curricula duties in Government and Government-aided schools, are given less teaching periods and have more free periods than teachers who do only teaching, and if he will look into the matter.
- *2. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister for Labour whether he will consider establishing registration centres of the Employment Exchange in all the 51 constituencies so that unemployed persons may register or re-register themselves, as the case may be, in their respective constituencies and need not have to incur unnecessary transport expenditure in having to go to the Labour Ministry at Havelock Road.
- *3. **Mr. Tay Boon Too:** To ask the Minister of State (Prime Minister's Department) whether Government will consider reducing the annual road tax for tricycles, used for carrying goods, from \$43 to \$20 the minimum annual tax for motor cycles.
