  - 2. The Minister for Commerce and Industry to move—

That this Assembly, in accordance with subsection (2) of section 1 of the Control of Imports and Exports Ordinance (Chapter 214), resolves that the aforesaid Ordinance shall continue in force for a further period of one year commencing on the 8th day of December, 1956.

3. The Minister for Local Government, Lands and Housing to move—

That this Assembly, in accordance with section 4 of the Foreshores Ordinance (Chapter 246), approves the reclamation by Messrs. John I. Thornycroft and Company Limited as agents of the Government, at the expense of the said Messrs. John I. Thornycroft and Company Limited and subject to an indemnity to be previously given by the said Messrs. John I. Thornycroft and Company Limited to the Government against all claims in any manner arising out of or in connection with such reclamation or the work thereof, and subject to such other conditions as the Governor may impose, of that portion of the foreshore and sea-bed containing an area of approximately 20,000 square feet adjoining Lot 571-1, Mukim XXV, at Tanjong Rhu as delineated on plans which have been approved by the Director of Public Works and are deposited at the Land Office, Singapore.

4. The Financial Secretary to move—

(Governor's recommendation or consent to be signified).

That this Assembly resolves that the sum of \$250,589 shall be supplied to the Government under the heads of expenditure and for the services specified in the Schedule contained in Sessional Paper No. Cmd. 47 of 1956.

The Financial Secretary to move—

That this Assembly, in accordance with paragraph (2) of Standing Order 61, resolves that the Financial Statements for the year 1954, as contained in Sessional Paper No. Cmd. 3 of 1956, together with the Report of the Director of Audit, Malaya, thereon, as contained in Sessional Paper No. Cmd. 7 of 1956, should be referred to the Public Accounts Committee.
