QUESTIONS FOR ORAL ANSWER

- *1. Mr. Ho See Beng: To ask the Minister for Education whether and when his Ministry will commence negotiations with the Singapore Teachers' Union on claims submitted during 1961 relating to (a) anomalies in the salary structure in the Teaching Service between the normal-trained, the old certificated-trained and the new certificated-trained teachers and the graduates; and (b) the re-introduction of the one Principal one session school system as was in practice before.
- *2. Mr. Ho See Beng: To ask the Minister for Education whether teachers in the aided schools are not provided with similar medical facilities as their counterparts in the Government Service, although they perform identical duties, and why.
