NOTICES OF AMENDMENTS TO BILLS

IN COMMITTEE

TRADE UNIONS (AMENDMENT) BILL [BILL NO. 69]

Clause 1:

Note:—In page 1, line 4: to leave out “1965” and insert “1966”.

Clause 3:

Minister for Labour:

(1) In page 2: to leave out lines 4 to 10 inclusive and the marginal note and insert —

“Strike or industrial action.

24A.—(1) A registered trade union shall not commence, promote, organise or finance any strike or any form of industrial action affecting the whole or any section of its members without obtaining the consent, by secret ballot, of the majority of the members so affected.”.

(2) In page 2: to leave out lines 23 to 32 inclusive and insert —

“(4) For the purposes of this section “industrial action” means the adoption of any practice, procedure or method in the performance of work which would result in a limitation on output or production in any occupation, service, trade, industry or business.”.

New Clause:

Minister for Labour:

“Amendment of section 18B.

Section 18B of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word “funds” appearing in the fourth line thereof and substituting therefor the word “property”.”.

Note:—It is intended that this new clause be inserted immediately after clause 2.

Consequential Amendments:

Amendments to be made to the numbering of clauses consequent on the addition of new clause 3.

Amendments proposed to Bill upon recommitment

Clause 49:

In page A15, line 44: to leave out “three years” and insert “one year”.

Clause 52:

In page A18, after line 17: to insert —

“(c) the custody, maintenance and education of the minor children of the parties; and”.

Consequential amendments:

- (1) **In page A18, line 17:** to leave out “and”.
- (2) **In page A18, line 18:** to re-letter paragraph “(c)” as paragraph “(d)”.

Clause 65:

In page A23, line 27: to leave out “investment” and insert “investments”.

Clause 82:
